Overview - Career Angels Program

An all **volunteer grassroots movement** and **complimentary career management program** that assists and empowers job seekers by providing them with career advice, resources, tools and support on a one-on-one basis from pre-screened, qualified career professionals.

Career Angels - Qualifications

1. **Altruistically motivated, experienced** career professionals from across the country that are interested in **making a positive impact** on people's lives by helping them through the career management process.
2. **5 or more years of hands-on experience** assisting job seekers in a career related profession
3. **Dependable**

How it Works

1. Each Career Angel is paired with a new job seeker every two weeks, (e.g. 2 job seekers/month).
2. Every other Monday, our Career Angels Case Manager will notify you via email regarding the job seeker that has been assigned to you.
3. As a Career Angel you would connect with the job seekers assigned to you within 48 hours to schedule an in-person and or virtual meeting (depending upon your preference), during a time, and in a manner that is convenient for you.



Resources Available

We've made helping someone easy by creating a full suite of easy-to-use career management tools, services and programs that all of our Career Angels can use in conjunction with their own tools and resources to assist job seekers with their **career, skill set, and job search** in a thorough and supportive manner.

Expectations

1. Commit to being a Career Angel for at least a 6-month period of time. (That means supporting a total of 12 job seekers, one every two weeks).
2. The amount of time devoted to being a Career Angel varies, but a typical Career Angel spends between 2 and 4 hours per week with each job seeker.
3. Respond to your job seeker within a 48-hour time period.
4. Notify our Career Angel's Case Manager if you are unable to assist someone that has been assigned to you for any reason.
5. Own your own laptop, phone, and have internet access.
